SIGN THE FOLLOWING COVENANT OF MUTUAL COVENANT AND CO-RESPONSIBILITY
INHERENT IN THE ATTENDANCE OF _____ AT THE ABOVE-
MENTIONED SERVICE.

Specifically, the parent (or holder of parental responsibility) declares:

- that they are aware of the infection mitigation measures in force as of today, committing to maintain for themselves and their child/children the prevention rules already in use;
- to undertake to accompany his/her child/children to school/nursery respecting the prescriptions for the regulation of entry and exit flows in the individual sections established by the Manager, strictly respecting the physical distancing with other people present in the plexus and also undertaking to wait for his/her turn to enter and not to create gatherings outside the plexus;
- to undertake to constantly monitor their child's health status, avoiding bringing him/her to school/nursery in the presence of symptoms typical of Covid-19 such as acute respiratory symptoms such as coughing with difficulty breathing, vomiting (repeated episodes accompanied by malaise), diarrhea (three or more discharges with semiliquid or liquid stools), loss of taste, loss of smell, intense headache; an exception is rhinorrhea (cold), i.e., the presence of respiratory symptoms with minor nasal discharge, which is very common in children;
- to undertake to keep their son/daughter at home in the presence of fever (greater than 37.5°) and/or even one of the above-mentioned Covid-19-referable symptoms and/or in case of positive SARS-Cov-2 diagnostic test;
- to be aware and accept that their child/children, who present symptoms indicative of infection during the educational day, will be subjected to fever measurement with a non-contact

thermometer and that, in case of fever above 37.5° or in the presence of even one of the other symptoms mentioned above, the procedure of isolation and immediate return home will be activated: the child will be housed in the dedicated room or isolation area, specially prepared, and the parents will be immediately notified;

- in the event that the procedure for return home has been activated, the parents undertake to promptly go to the school/daycare center to pick up the child/children and immediately inform the Pediatrician of Free Choice (PLS) or the General Practitioner (GP) of the episode, adopting the appropriate precautions and procedures indicated by them;

- in the case of a positive diagnostic test, for return to school, parents agree to produce the **negative test result** (rapid antigenic or molecular) at the end of the planned isolation;

- in the case of pupils/children with frailty who, due to the SARS-CoV-2 virus, are more exposed to the risk of developing adverse symptoms, parents notify the School Institution of this condition in written and documented form, also specifying any protective measures to be activated during their presence at school. Following the report received, the School Institution evaluates the specific situation in liaison with the territorial prevention department and the pediatrician/family doctor to identify the appropriate precautionary measures to be applied to ensure the pupil's attendance in presence and under safe conditions.

In particular, the Manager declares:

- that it has provided, at the time of enrollment, information with respect to any organizational and hygienic-sanitary arrangements adopted to mitigate Covid-19 infection and that it undertakes, during the period of attendance, to communicate any changes or additions to the arrangements;

- that for the implementation of the educational service it employs staff adequately trained on the aspects referable to the current hygienic and sanitary procedures aimed at the mitigation of the infection. The staff itself undertakes to scrupulously observe any hygienic-sanitary prescriptions and to go to work only in the absence of any symptoms referable to Covid-19;

- to adhere strictly and scrupulously, in the case of an ascertained Covid-19 infection by a child/adult attending the service, to any provision of the local health authority.

The signing of this covenant commits the parties to abide by it in good faith. From a legal point of view, it does not release, the parties who sign it, from any liability in case of non-compliance with regulations related to the containment of the Covid-19 epidemic, ordinary regulations on safety in the workplace and Directives issued by the competent bodies.
