The 2023 Mayors Summit Against Antisemitism – hosted by the **City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida**, and chaired by its Mayor, **Dean Trantalis**, in partnership with the **Combat Antisemitism Movement (CAM)**, under the banner of "**Cities Unite Against Hate**" – is bringing together municipal leaders from dozens of cities throughout North America and across the globe to share the challenges faced and compare best practices on the city-level in the collective effort against the world's oldest hatred.
